As of November 1, 2009, EPF members are now able to apply for the new “EPF Visacard”.

The financial services provider PAYANGO now offers a prepaid Visa credit card in cooperation with reputable partners such as Visacard, the Baden-Württemberg state bank and the European Press Federation e.V. (EPF). What’s so special about this card: no information from credit protection agencies required. Credit basis. Very reasonable annual fee and other outstanding benefits. One feature particularly worthy of note is the interest of 2% p.a. paid on credit and booked directly to your card account.

Who is the EPF prepaid card suitable for? Applications for this credit card can be made by all members of the European Press Federation aged 18 and up. The only essential requirement is a current account at a German bank or savings bank. This Visacard is a prepaid credit card on credit basis. Therefore no credit protection agency information or examination of your financial standing is necessary. No proof of income required.

This is a prepaid credit card with EMC chip. On the back of the card, you will find the three-digit security code necessary for use in the internet. The card is valid for four years but can be cancelled at any time. The annual fee is 25 Euro p.a. Interest on credit: 2 percent. The card is accepted by 29 million Visa partners worldwide and can be recharged at any time by direct debit. With your personal PIN, you can withdraw cash from more than one million cash dispensers.

The EPF Visacard offers you absolute security, and the prepaid function prevents you from getting into debt. No credit protection agency information or proof of income is necessary. Card transactions can be viewed online at any time. The card issuer is the Baden-Württemberg state bank.

And: Only members of the European Press Federation can apply for the new “EPG Visacard”.
